



Clinical Members: use of CAPA NSW's logo

Full Clinical Members of CAPA NSW are eligible to use the CAPA NSW logo on their business cards, websites and advertising material.

The right to use the logo is free of charge and is restricted to Clinical Members who:

- must be a current financial member of CAPA NSW;
- must not have fees or documents outstanding; and
- must not have current issues before the Ethics committee.

The logo must only be displayed in a way that makes it clear that this is a logo confirming that the practitioner is a clinical member of CAPA NSW. The logo must not be used to state or imply endorsement by CAPA NSW of any website information or workshop content.

Clinical Members may contact the CAPA NSW office to request the logo, which will be supplied as a standard jpeg file. The logo may be adjusted in size (maintaining the same dimensions) by the Clinical Member. No other adjustments may be made. The logo colour may not be changed.

Permission to use the logo is provided in good faith that should a Clinical Member leave CAPA NSW s/he will no longer use the logo in any communications and publicity materials.

Any Clinical Member who misuses the logo is subject to disciplinary action by CAPA NSW, which may include, but is not limited to, a requirement to remove the logo from materials; to destroy materials incorporating the CAPA logo; and/or membership may be suspended or cancelled.
